MEAGAN & IAN | DENVER BOTANIC GARDENS



AT THE TIME of their engagement, Denver transplants Meagan and Ian lived in Uptown, close to the Botanic Gardens. “We would go over there for a quick dose of the outdoor Colorado that we moved to Colorado for,” says Meagan.
